# Children & Families...

## SBC Kids & Mission:

Starting this Sunday, SBC Kids will be partnering with the Grenada Missions Team and the work Seeds International is doing as our missions focus for the winter and spring term. We are excited at some of the opportunities the kids will have to have a part in the trip as well as learn from the team as they watch and hear stories of their experience.

Listed are some of the ways we will be partnering and encouraging the team:

- Feb 12 – Valentines Candy Bag Fundraiser - After 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> services SBC Kids will selling candy bags to raise funds to help pay for resource materials the Grenada Team will give to children as they make their way to different schools. These resources include a backpack filled with a Bible, worksheets and crayons.
- Words of Encouragement - As the Grenada Team fills backpacks for the children, we will be taking the opportunity to also encourage the children the team is ministering to by giving them a picture of your child with their name, a word of encouragement and their favourite verse on it. Over the next few weeks as we prepare, we would like for families to help their child(ren) learn and memorize their favourite verse. - Pick a Time - From March 16-March 26, while the Grenada team is away, we want to encourage children and their families to pray. On Sunday March 11 there will time spots for families to choose when to pray for the team. Each family will receive a picture of the team when they pick a time spot. Our goal is that the team will be prayed for around the clock as they are on the trip.

Along with these different activities, children will be able to hear from members of the team before and after they go on the trip.

### **A Support Group with Focus**

After viewing the video, DivorceCare group participants spend time as a support group, discussing what was presented in that week's video seminar and what is going on in the lives of group members.

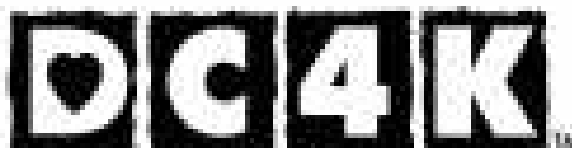

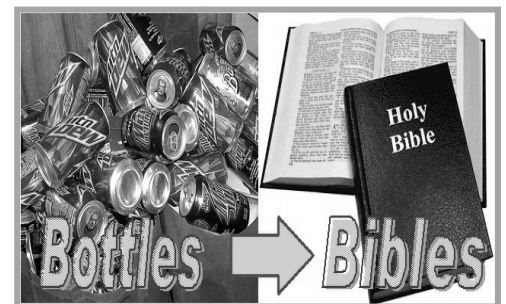
## Grenada Mission Trip
